### *6 Meters in the Bay*, Special Commission Painting by David Bareford

### *1/2 Model of Nocturne*



The sloop *Nocturne* was designed by Sparkman & Stephens in 1935 for racing and cruising. This 20" x 28" half model of *Nocturne* was built by George W. Delano, Jr. for display purposes and includes a half hull with deck houses, cockpit coamings, and toe rails with turned and cast brass fittings, full mast and spars, and raised sails on original mahogany backboard with an engraved brass plate.
